Ten tips to help you reduce your CO2 emissions at the source.

Here are 10 things you can do to save energy at home and help stop Global Warming!

1. Change a light:

Changing one regular light bulb for one compact fluorescent light bulb will save 67.5 kg of carbon dioxide a year.

2. Drive less:

Walk, bike, carpool, or take mass transit more often. Save over 0.300 kg per km.

3. Recycle more:

You can save 1,080 kg of carbon dioxide per year just by recycling half of your household waste.

4. Check your tires:

Keeping your tires inflated properly can improve fuel consumption by more than 3%. Every litre of fuel saved keeps 2.4 kg of carbon dioxide out of the atmosphere.

5. Use less hot water:

It takes a lot of energy to heat water. Use less hot water by installing a low flow showerhead (157 kg of CO₂ saved per year) and washing your clothes in cold or warm water (225 kg per year).

6. Avoid products with a lot of packaging:

You can save 540 kg of carbon dioxide if you cut down on your garbage by 10%.

7. Adjust your thermostat:

Moving your thermostat just two degrees in the winter and up two degrees in the summer could save about 900 kg of carbon dioxide per year.

8. Plant a tree:

A single tree will absorb over 1 ton of carbon dioxide in its lifetime!

9. Turn off electronic devices:

Simply turn off your television, dvd player, stereo, and computer when you're not using them...you will save thousands of kg of carbon dioxide a year.
